

# SITE INFORMATION

## ATM

There are ATMs located inside the Big Rock Festival tent at the east end of the field.

## Baby Changing Tent

We have provided a tent near the portables on the north side of the park for changing your baby. Please do not drop your used diapers in the portables, use the waste bin provided.

## Potable Water

There are two “rehydration stations” located in the park - one just south of the front gate and one behind the Vendors row on the main track. Please refill your bottles there, and please be respectful of the equipment. These are not toys. Water in single-use plastic bottles will not be offered for sale on the site.

Re-usable bottles are on sale at various locations in the park, including our retail booth inside the Big Rock festival tent..

## Emergencies and First Aid

Please report any injuries or accidents to Games Security volunteers who are easily identified by their yellow Canmore Highland Games vests.

Do not move a bodily-injured party until attended to by security or first-aid personnel. People with minor cuts and bruises can be escorted to the Security Security area in the large festival tent.

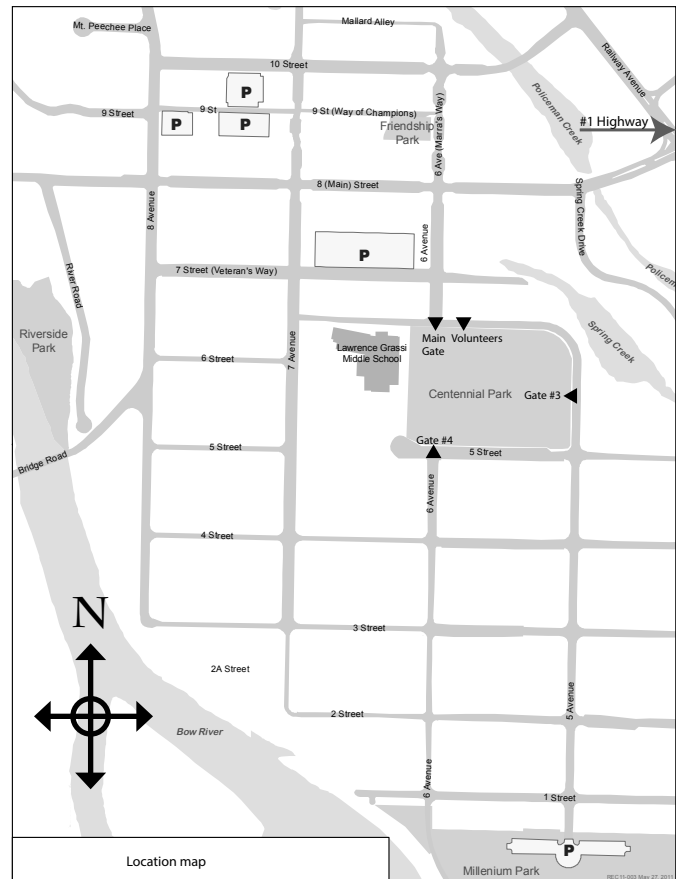
## Help & Lost and Found

Due to the large crowds that attend the Games, pets and bikes are not permitted on the site. Please do not tie your pet to the fence or leave it unattended in your car. Please lock your bike to permanent fences only.

## Security Area

The security area is located inside the Big Rock festival tent at the east side by the entrance. Enter the tent and ask any volunteer to point you to it.

## Toilets

Flush toilets and sinks are located on the south side of the park, portable toilets at the rear of the Big Rock festival tent (accessible from inside) and portables and hand-wash stations are placed strategically throughout the park.
